The following is an extract taken from Fr Dennis Nulty's video message on icatholic.ie in advance of his ordination as Bishop of Kildare and Leighlin.

"I think this motto sums up the word gladness. The joy that all of us need to feel in our faith at this time.

A time that's difficult for people, pressurising for many and, hopefully, I see the word serve as that we all would serve the Lord in whatever we can;

do our bit to spread faith,

and bring joy into peoples' lives.

So I hope that I will serve the Lord with gladness here in Kildare and Leighlin and I hope that you will serve the Lord with me."

The ordination ceremony will be streamed live on the internet via iCatholic.ie.

The broadcast will begin from approximately 2.40pm.
