Make me every ready to come to you with straight eyes,

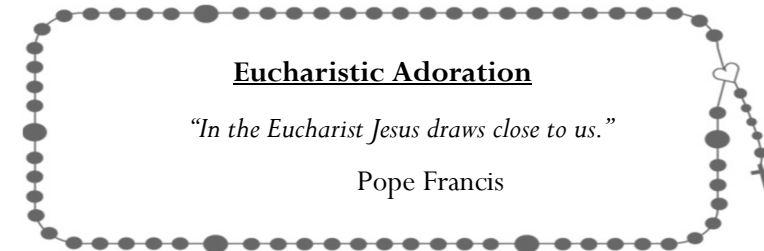
so that when life fades as the fading sunset,

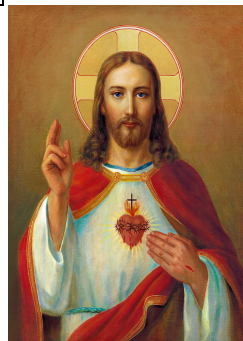
